ACTION ITEMS Property Coverage

Selby reported on final property coverage options for the 2020-21 year. These include APIP, a national public entity program, and a new purchasing group being explored by several CA risk pools. Both options provide same or higher coverage then current, include value-added services like appraisals, and project lower rates. Pursuing either of these options means withdrawing from the BASIC property program, which requires approval by the governing body of NBSIA, with withdrawal notice due by January 31. Staff therefore requested authority to withdraw from BASIC.

Motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Henson, and carried unanimously to give authority to the Executive Director to withdraw from the BASIC property program to secure a more favorable long-term coverage option. (Ayes: Welch, Henson, Schultz, Best; Noes: none; Absent: none; Abstain: none)
