HEALTHY SCHOOLS ACT

The Healthy Schools Act requires anyone using any pesticide at a school or child care center to complete Healthy Schools Act training.

Employees who need training include:

- · Childcare Staff
- · Custodians
- Mainteance Workers
- Office Staff
- · Operations Workers
- · Pest Management Professional
- · Student Nutrition Workers
- · Teachers



All courses include information about integrated pest management (IPM), the safe use of pesticides at school sites, and the Healthy Schools Act. Only one course needs to be taken to meet the training requirement. The courses are available in English and Spanish through TargetSolutions.

BASIC IPM FOR THE CLASSROOM & OFFICE

This 25 minute course is for bus drivers, childcare staff, office staff, student nutrition workers and teachers to understand the basics of integrated pest management.

INTEGRATED GERM MANAGEMENT

This 40 minute course is for people who mainly use antimicrobial pesticides, sanitizers and disinfectants, at schools and child-care centers. This course may best fit custodians who clean and disinfect as part of their regular job duties.

BEST PEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES AROUND CHILDREN (ADVANCED)

This 1 hour advanced-level course is designed for maintenance, operations and licensed pest management professionals who provide service at schools and child care centers. Upon completion, course takers receive one hour of continuing education credit for DPR and SPCB licenses
