What is IPM?

As of July 1, 2016, the Healthy Schools Act requires IPM training for anyone who applies a pesticide at a school or child care center. The training teaches pesticide effects, approved pesticides, and safe usage.



Who Needs IPM?

All IPM Coordinators and *anyone* who may apply a pesticide* *at a school* are required to have training.

**This includes, but is not limited to, disinfecting wipes, sanitizers and weed killers.*



How Often?

The Healthy Schools Act requires this one-hour training to be completed annually.
