

REPORTING A SERIOUS INJURY OR ILLNESS TO CAL/OSHA

Every employer shall report immediately by telephone to the nearest District Office of the Division of Occupational Safety & Health any serious injury or illness, or death of an employee occurring in a place of employment or in connection with any employment.

WHAT QUALIFIES?



Serious injury or illness means:

Any injury or illness occurring in a place of employment, or in connection with any employment, which requires inpatient hospitalization for more than 24 hours for other than medical observation, **OR** in which an employee suffers a loss of any member of the body or any serious degree permanent disfigurement, but does not include any injury or illness or death caused by the commission of Penal Code violation. except the violation Section 385 of the Penal Code, or an accident on a public street or highway.

WHEN TO REPORT?



Immediate means:

As soon as practically possible but not longer than 8 hours after the employer knows—or with diligent inquiry would have known—of the serious injury or illness. Report by phone 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

If the employer can demonstrate that exigent circumstances exist, the time frame for the report may be made no longer than 24 hours after the incident.

The employer means:

Someone in a management or supervisory capacity.

WHAT TO REPORT?



- ·Time and date of accident
- ·Employer's name, address and telephone number
- ·Name and job title of person reporting the accident
- ·Site address of accident/event
- ·Name of person to contact at site of accident
- ·Name and address of injured employee(s)
- ·Nature of injury
- ·Location where injured person was moved to
- ·List and identity of other law enforcement agencies present at the site of accident
- Description of accident and whether the accident scene or instrumentality has been altered

REPORT TO WHOM?



Report the serious injury, illness or fatality to the nearest Cal/OSHA District Office. Ask for the Officer of the Day.
