

CYBER SECURITY TIPS FOR A SAFE REOPENING



Practice good password hygiene

Use strong passwords at least 8 characters in length.

Use a mix of upper and lowercase letters, numbers, and special characters.

Don't include personal information or use the same password for multiple devices.

91% of successful data breaches starts with a spear phishing attack

Safeguard devices when in transit

Make sure devices are off or locked.

Keep other personal items in your car out of site to prevent break-ins.

Store devices in trunk or hidden location prior to departure if not heading directly to office/home.

Encrypt and password-protect confidential data on USB or hard drives.

Report lost or stolen devices or data storage immediately.

Do not store confidential data on CDs in transit.

Do not store password or login information with or near device.

It takes 3 seconds for ransomware to start encrypting files in your computer.
