## CYBER SECURITY TIPS FOR A SAFE REOPENING



Practice good password hygiene Use strong passwords at least 8 characters in length.

Use a mix of upper and lowercase letters, numbers, and special characters. Don't include personal information or use the same password for multiple devices.

91% of successful data breaches starts with a spear phishing attack

Safeguard devices when in transit Make sure devices are off or locked.

Encrypt and passwordprotect confidential data on USB or hard drives.

confidential data on CDs in transit.

Do not store

It takes 3 seconds for ransomware to start encrypting files in your computer. Store devices in trunk or hidden location prior to departure if not heading directly to office/home.

Do not store password or login information with or near device. Keep other personal items in your car out of site to prevent breakins.

Report lost or stolen devices or data storage immediately.
